# Event Planning

- Set date for K9 Karnivale: September 14, 2008 10am to 1pm. Begin to think about possible vendors, advertising, possible donations
- Dog Wash(s?): Mid-August, the 9<sup>th</sup> tentative
- Birthday Party: July 12 (a Saturday)
- **KOFFEE KLATSCH:** Next date is May 3, 7:30 to 10:00 am (Same shifts?) Location is Coliseum Park, June 7<sup>th</sup> (Mary Richardson Park?) then to resume in September after other events
- Bone Installation date yet to be determined, not sure how we'll install them.

#### **Grant Bark Park**

## GM discussed proposed Architectural Plan designed by Judy Prindable

- Ideas included making sure the plantings aren't toxic to dogs, need lots of shade and water, shade sails described to add shade to south end of park (she has offered to purchase them)
- Also possibly a rain barrel at south end that would be a source of water at that end (how to fill
  if no rain hose?); carpeting on parts of the gravel area (more paw friendly), move trash
  containers and have some kind of plantings at the corners to shield them so not obvious.
- Other suggestions were leash hanging hooks, biodegradable bags (\$96 for 2400 bags), large hand sanitizer (would Pet Smart donate it?), is it toxic to dogs, would the dispenser be inside or outside of park, time out space for aggressive dogs, dog house?
- Plantings to include green, blue and yellow planters, vertical grasses to add visual diversity, raised beds with wheat grasses, tree limbs, boulders to provide "zen pens" for shy dogs or to chill out or separate large and smaller dogs, boulders placed to discourage dogs peeing on trees, plastic fire hydrants (filled with gravel), may be donated by Soggy Paws
- Important safety ideas included having a first aid kit and emergency numbers of closest dog vet and emergency ER number posted.
- Enlisting Columbia students to produce fence murals to hang on chain length fences, also hanging vines and self-watering planter boxes
- Suggestions to be considered and discussed further ©.
- Gravel Report: Gravel can be put down soon, if the weather EVER improves

#### Coliseum Park

- Discussion of cleaning up the park before new gravel and other improvements
- · Remove old gravel, possibly power wash the gravel that's there to reduce odor
- Find out what we can get done through the Dog Friendly Area committee at the Park District (Janis Taylor, chair)
- MG will look into the name of a company who might make a vertical cabinet for storage at Coliseum Park.
